
This is the first year that Computerworld Wales analysed its emissions. This represents a normal year as it was a post-covid year.

Carbon Reduction Projects

The following measures have been implemented since the 2023 baseline.

- Switched office to entirely LED lighting and away from fluorescent tubing
- Migration of several core computing processes to the cloud
- Actively making more and more work for customers able to be carried out remotely to reduce company van usage.

In future we plan to implement further measures as

- PIR based lighting to enable auto shutoff
- Replacing diesel vans with BEV as practical
- Encouraging staff to utilise public transport where applicable
- Investigate the installation of solar to reduce electricity
- Encourage suppliers to utilise lower CO2 methods of delivery for equipment.

To see if we are able to obtain net zero before the 2050 deadline, we will be investigating relevant carbon offset projects.

Scope 3 emissions are still in the process of being gathered and consolidated. Figures will be updated as soon as possible.
