Mortality, morbidity and lifestyle health factors

Definitions

SMR: The standardised mortality rate is the ratio of the expected number of deaths for sex and age band, to the expected number if they had the same age-specific rates as the standard population.

Smoke: Self-reported to clinician (not insurance related) that they smoke any tobacco

Obese: Clinically obese, for most ages a Body Mass Index (BMI) over 30

Health / Disability: Self-reported in Census
