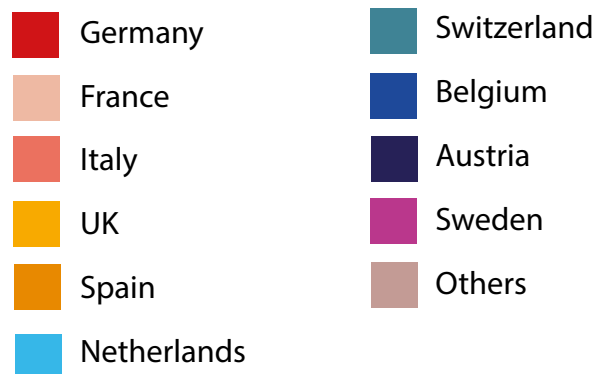
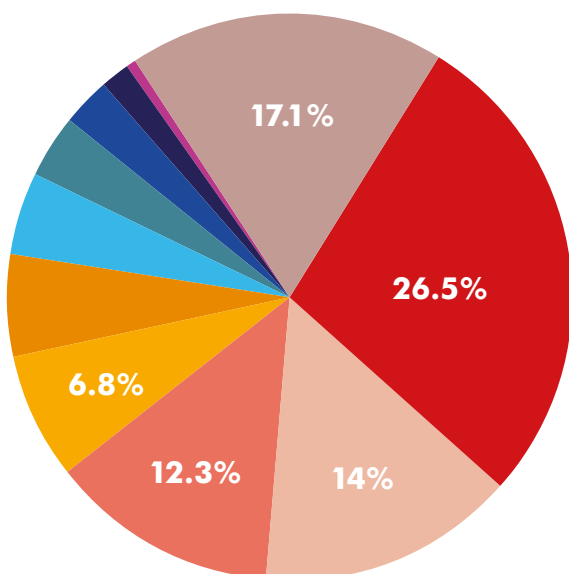
With its world-class infrastructure, highly skilled workforce, and strong ties to leading universities and research institutes, the region drives much of Europe's medtech innovation.
