WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE LADYBIRD CLASS




The Ladybird Room will have soil and small pots in their tuff tray to practice “**planting**” they will also colour some beautiful flowers to make a lovely garden for the wall.



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WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE CATERPILLER CLASS

The Caterpillar Room will be reading “The Very Hungry Caterpillar” and “Grow It”





WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE BUTTERFLY ROOM
