Ownership strategy to include where we are going with the stadium situation and the finances.

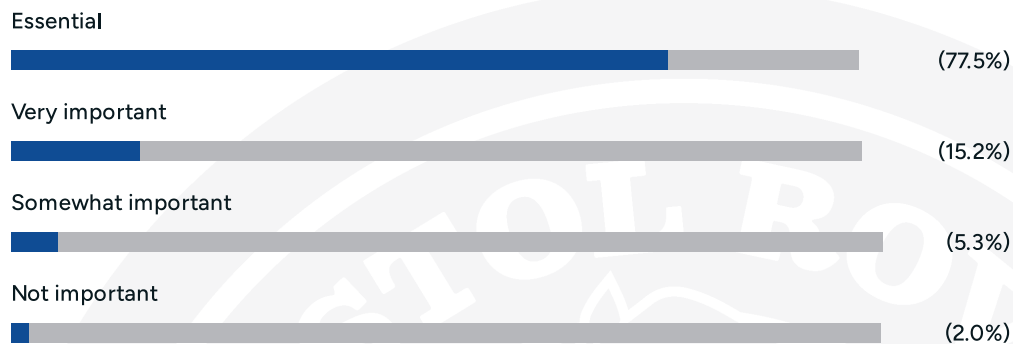

Ownership strategy, although tbh there's little point now. Any info from owners at this point is only to appease.

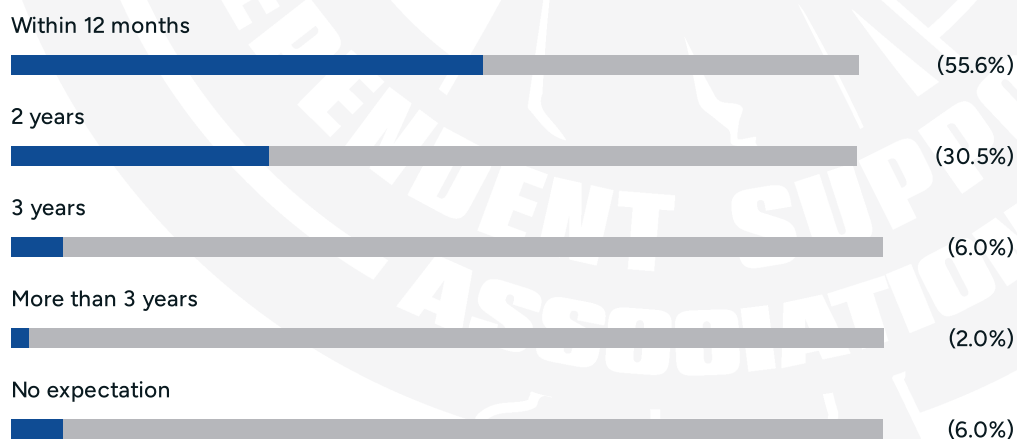

Why do the owners keep changing plans, when will they actually front up and tell the truth?

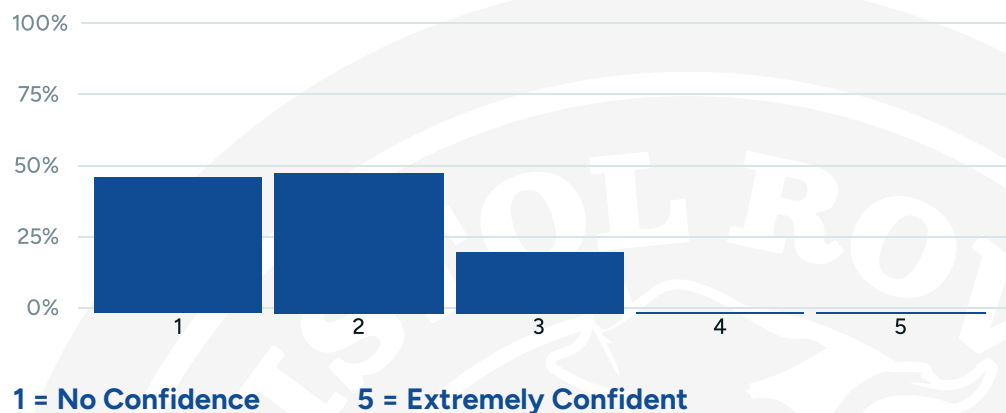
“How important is a new stadium to the long term future of Bristol Rovers?”



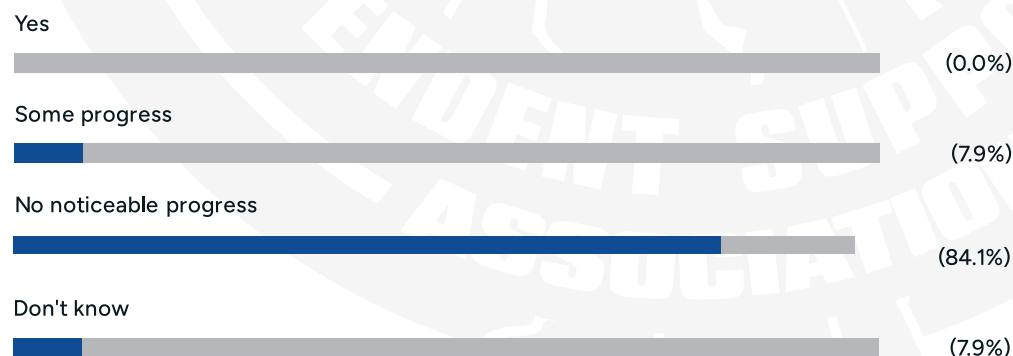
“From August 2026: What would you consider an acceptable timeframe for the club to identify a viable stadium a solution?”



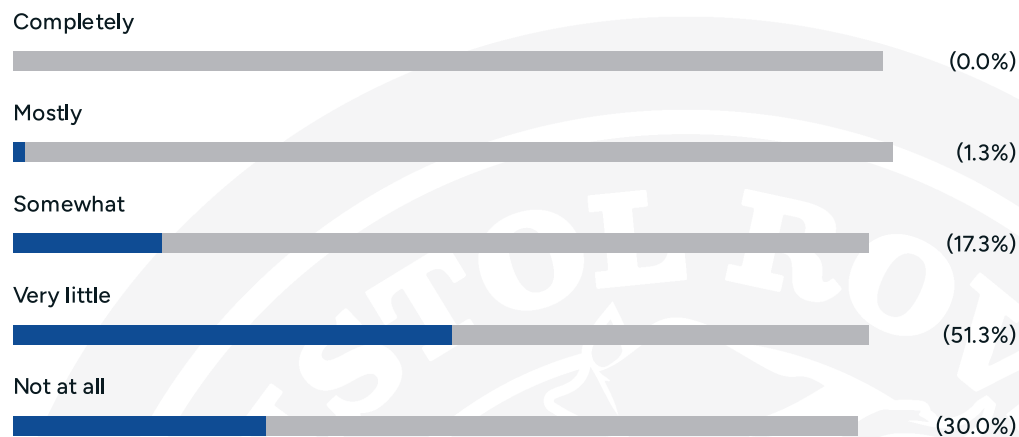
“How confident are you that the club currently has a clear stadium strategy?”



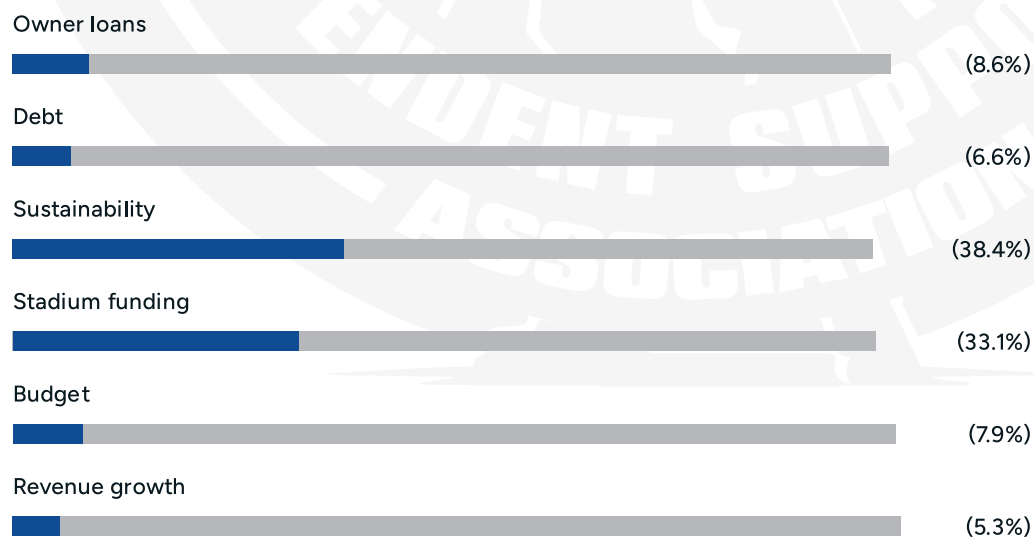
“Compared with 12 months ago, do you believe meaningful progress has been made towards a new stadium?”

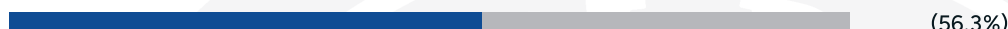

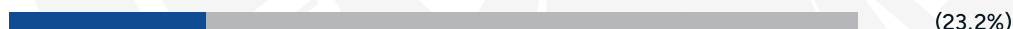

To put a coherent leadership structure and plan in place. Who is in what position, what experience do they have and why are they in that position. Less 'jobs for the boys'; more professional, experienced people in position.

Stadium.If its not possible to redevelop The Mem then the club simply cannot progress without a new Stadium.

As above a clear, coherent stadium plan roadmap.

Make a clear decision on staying at the Memorial Stadium as I personally see no realistic opportunity of the owners finding a suitable site for new stadium. Also where would the funding come from besides the sale of the Mem as the club seems to have no idea as to stem the yearly financial losses.

Location and time frame for new stadium

Find new owners who understand how to run a club properly. Surviving isn't anything to celebrate at all.

No clear plan, no club/supporter bond, no infrastructure plan, no relationship with past players or acknowledgment of club history(this is done by volunteers or non exec individuals), terrible hospitality and catering cheap and tacky, possibly due to the club provisions.

Awful toilets and general experience for old and young guests.

Plans for a new stadium to guarantee the long term future of the club.

Medium/Long term plans for the club with the stadium number one priority.

To confirm a plan regarding the stadium

Clear plans for off pitch activities, stadium new or redevelopment of existing, training and development, women's teams, youth development plus development of additional income streams.

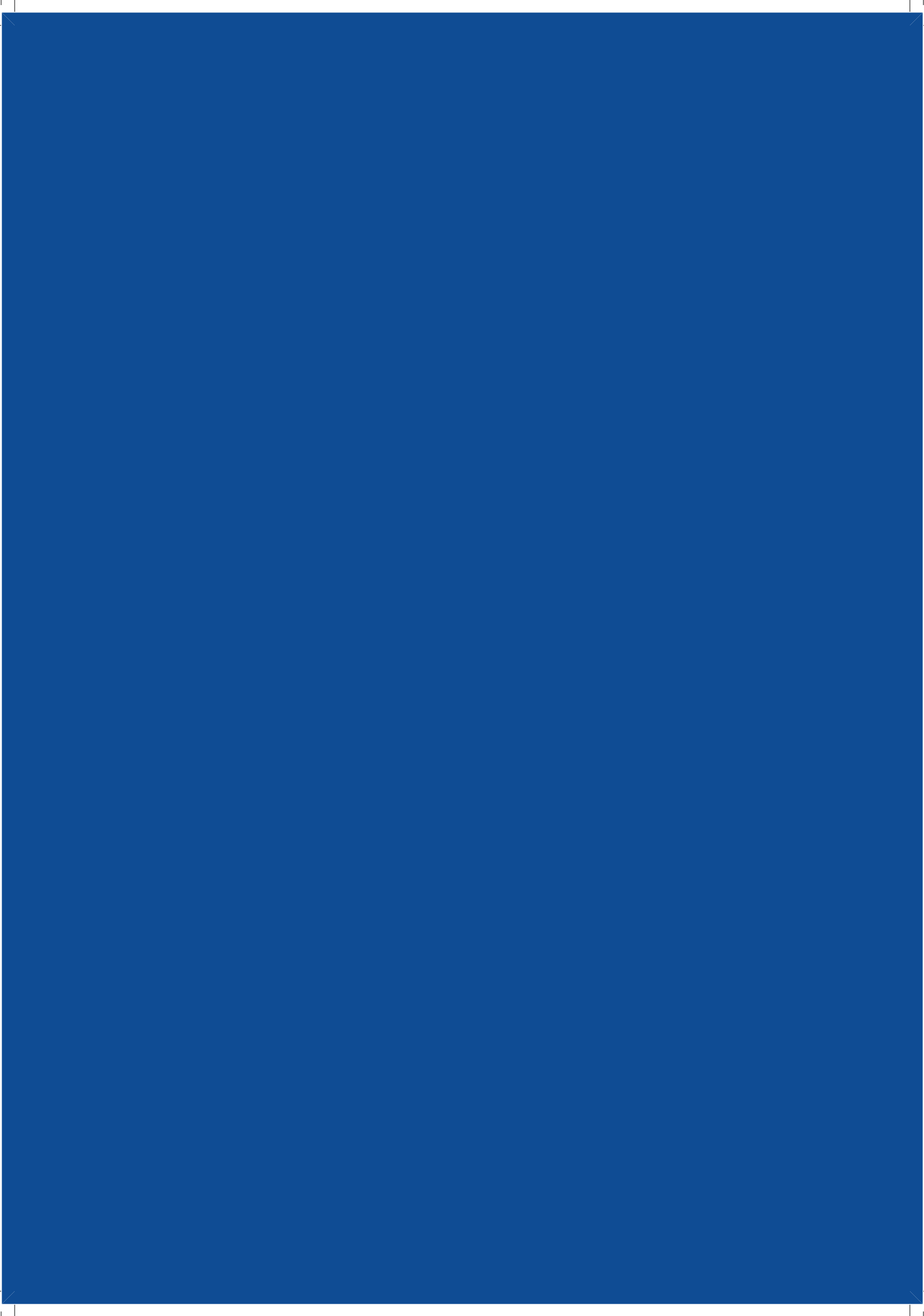
