Course Description

The NPA Film & Media (Level 6) has been designed to offer you an introduction to the film and media sectors, and practical experience of developing and delivering your own creative project.

You will study 4 units: Film and the Film Industry: An Introduction, Creative Project, and two other units taken from a range of optional units, e.g. Media - Feature Writing, Storytelling for the Creative Industries, Media - basic Video Editing, Digital Media - Video Editing.

The homework will be personalised to you, dependant on your particular area of interest within the collaborative setting of film making.


