We expect all Spectators, Players/Carers attending a Balanced Minds FC game to play their part and always observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers.



I will

- Have fun; it is what we are all here for!
- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides.
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same.
- Stay behind the respect barrier and within the Designated spectator's Area.
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement to try again next time.
- Never Engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behavior
- Attend presentations that the club puts on.
- Make the apposing team feel welcome (parents, staff, and players)
- Have a positive, friendly attitude when watching a game.
- Report any concerns to the support team or welfare officer.
- Attend as many pre-season training sessions as possible.
- If invited to listen to the team talk, I will respect the views of the management team.
- Make the Management team aware of any conditions that your child may have.
- Make the Management team aware of any concerns if you notice a sudden change in your child's behavior patterns.

I understand that if I do not follow the code.

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave the game or training session.
- Required to meet with the club committee or welfare officer.
- Asked to undertake an FA education course.
- Suspended from attending future games.
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.
