

<p><b>Course Title:</b> Creating a Meaningful Day</p>	<p><b>Duration:</b> Full/Half day</p>
<p><b>Broad Aims:</b> To give the learner knowledge on how to create a meaningful day using activities that are both low cost and easy to initiate within a Health and Social care environment.</p>	
<p><b>Overview</b></p> <p>This course has been designed with the individual in mind. It explores ways in which care staff can create an environment which is enthused with interest and enjoyment regardless of abilities.</p> <p>The course looks at ways of stimulating the individual using low cost and easy to use ideas that help to maintain both physical and cognitive functioning.</p>
