How Monthly Fees Are Calculated

To make budgeting easier, we spread fees evenly across 12 monthly payments. This means your monthly payment remains consistent throughout the year rather than changing depending on the number of weeks in each month.

Monthly fees are calculated using the following formula:

$$\text{Weekly Fee} \times 49 \text{ Weeks} \div 12 \text{ Months} = \text{Fixed Monthly Fee}$$

If you are claiming the Free Early Education Entitlement and require additional sessions, your funded hours will be spread evenly across the year to calculate a consistent monthly fee.

Estimated Fees

The below examples are based on all year round, full-day attendance over 49 chargeable weeks per year and include meal fees.

Free Early Education Entitlement (FEEE)

Eligible children may be entitled to government-funded early education and childcare, depending on their age and their family's circumstances. Eligible working parents can access up to 30 hours of funded childcare per week from 9 months to school age for 38 weeks of the year. Some 2-year-olds who meet specific eligibility criteria may be entitled to 15 hours of funded early education per week, while all eligible 3- and 4-year-olds are entitled to 15 hours per week. Funding eligibility is determined by the government and/or local authority, and parents may need to apply for an eligibility code.

Meals & Snacks

Government funding covers childcare only and does not include meals, drinks or snacks.

Families have the choice to:

- Purchase freshly prepared nursery meals and snacks; or
- Provide a healthy packed lunch in line with our Packed Lunch Policy.

If you choose to provide your child's meals, please speak with the management team who will provide you with more information on our Packed Lunch Policy.
