### **Breakfast Club and After School Club.**

We are based in the Schoolhouse, within the school grounds. Renovated in 2024, the space has been thoughtfully designed with school-aged children in mind. Our setting provides a safe, welcoming, and stimulating environment where children can relax and unwind after a busy school day.

Children can enjoy a wide range of activities, including:

- Arts and crafts
- Wii games
- Role-play room
- Construction suite
- Board games
- Outdoor play

Our staff plan a full programme of activities for children to enjoy, and children are encouraged to help shape the planning process through our Children's Council. Above all, this is the children's setting: a home-from-home where they can play, feel comfortable and have fun.

Opening times: 7.15am to school, we provide our children with a selection of healthy cereals, toast, crumpets, fruit juice, and breakfast biscuits.

3.25pm: Our after-school club team, will collect your child (ren) from their classroom. We provide a home cooked tea, closing at 6pm.

To access the building, our entrance is next to the bakery on town street.

### **Forest School**

Our Forest School out-of-school club runs three evenings a week: Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. The club is led by our Forest School Manager and her team, who create a safe, engaging, and hands-on outdoor learning experience for the children.

Children take part in a variety of outdoor activities in our designated Forest School area and lodge, including:

- Exploring and playing outdoors
- Cooking on open fires
- Using real tools under supervision
- Developing confidence, independence, and practical skills

### **Holiday Club**

Our holiday club runs during every school holiday. We are open from 7.30am to 6.00pm each day, excluding bank holidays and the Christmas period.

Children enjoy a full program of exciting activities and trips, giving them plenty of opportunities to have fun, explore and make the most of their school holidays.

- Other seasonal activities and outings
- Forest School

We provide breakfast, a mid-morning snack and a light afternoon tea. Please provide your child with a packed lunch each day.

Once you are registered with us, you will receive a booking form and program. To book your child's place, please return the completed form and payment to our admin team. They will then confirm your booking.

### **Emma's Angels Employees**

At Emma's Angels, we recognise the importance of having highly trained and experienced staff. We actively encourage our team to continue their professional development through further training, helping them to grow in their roles and provide the best possible care for the children. We have a thorough induction and training program.

All staff are subject to Enhanced DBS checks, and references are always followed up and verified as part of our recruitment process.

Our aim is to provide every child with a warm, nurturing environment where they feel safe, happy, and supported.

- Our Deputy Room Manager is called Andrea, and she can be identified with a royal blue t-shirt.
- Our Senior Playworker is called Debbie, and she can be identified with a royal blue t-shirt.

### **Starting with us**

- Any other information that will help us support them.

This visit also gives you the opportunity to ask any questions you may have and helps your child become familiar with the setting.
