Re: Disneyland Paris Technologies Trip - June 2026

We are excited to announce an incredible opportunity for our young people to participate in the Technologies trip to Disneyland Paris. This trip is only open to young people currently in S1 and S2.

This 4-day package, scheduled for Tuesday 9th to Friday 12th June 2026, promises to be a truly magical trip.

Details of the trip are as follows:

Dates: Tuesday 9th - Friday 12th June 2026

Cost: £925 per person

Package Inclusions:

- Return flights from Edinburgh to Paris Charles de Gaulle (times to be confirmed)
- Return airport transfers in Paris
- Three nights' hotel accommodation at Disney's Hotel Cheyenne, Disney, Paris (subject to availability)
- Continental breakfast each day at the hotel
- Evening meal on at least two nights at a Disney restaurant
- Hopper Ticket to both Disneyland® Park and Walt Disney Studios® Park
- Interactive digital activities to support subject specific learning
- Fully comprehensive travel insurance
- Government taxes and service charges

Please note that parents are required to provide transport to and from Edinburgh airport. Young people will be responsible for purchasing their own lunches and snacks.

The trip is limited to 40 spaces. In the event that we receive more than 40 applications, a random draw will be conducted to assign the available spaces, and an ordered reserve list will be established.

A non-refundable deposit of £125 will be due by Friday 28th February, with eight subsequent monthly instalments of £100 in March, April, May, June, August, September, October, and November to facilitate manageable payment of the trip. Payment can be made using iPay, at the school office by card or with a cheque made payable to Falkirk Council.

If you are facing financial barriers that may hinder your young person's participation in this trip, we encourage you to reach out to us confidentially. We are committed to exploring potential solutions and ensuring that financial constraints do not prevent any interested young person from being part of it.

We kindly remind parents/carers that their young person is expected to uphold the usual high standards of behaviour during the trip. Parents/carers must remember that they would be responsible for any associated costs incurred in the event that their young person needed to return home due to unacceptable conduct.
