

Dear Parent/Carer,

In line with the previous correspondence, you will be aware that the Braes High School building is closed tomorrow, Friday 24th January, to both staff and pupils, due to the severe weather warnings. It is anticipated the school will be open as normal on Monday 27th January.

The arrangements for online learning tomorrow are outlined below:

- Pupils should follow their normal timetable, with online lessons taking place via Microsoft Teams, at the same times as usual.
- Staff will deliver online lessons, via Microsoft Teams in accordance with this timetable
- Lessons will comprise of a variety of interactions and activities. It is not anticipated that staff will always be 'on screen' with pupils for the entirety of the lesson. Rather, teachers may introduce the lesson, set tasks and check-in on the young people's progress.
- For young people in S1 and S2 who have PE on their timetable tomorrow, we would ask pupils to look at the 'Physical Education' section of their Year Group Teams, to see the tasks set. S3 pupils who have Core PE tomorrow periods 4 and 5 should do likewise.
- Where we have teachers absent, tasks will be set on the Class Teams pages.
- Unless previously indicated, we will assume all learners are attending virtual learning tomorrow.
- Pupils should take their breaks and the normal times.

Period 5 – 1.10pm until 2.00pm
Period 6 – 2.00pm until 2.50pm
