Please see an update on a number of matters below:

Face Coverings

Although the vast majority of young people bring a face covering with them to school, Falkirk Council secondary schools are having to issue a sizeable number each week. Please continue to remind your young person to bring a face covering to school each day.

COVID-19 procedures

Please remember that the best way for us to keep our school environment as safe as possible is to ensure vigilance for symptoms. Should any person in a household have COVID-19 symptoms, that person should book a PCR test, and the household should isolate until a negative result is received. Similarly, if someone tests positive with a Lateral Flow Test, the person with the positive test should book a PCR test and the rest of the household should isolate.
