Please find a letter from NHS Test and Protect, advising that their team is carrying out COVID-19 contact tracing at Braes High School. As the letter states, there is no need for your young person/people to self-isolate. This letter is sent simply to advise that there has been a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 within the school community, and to provide reassurance that the matter is being dealt with appropriately.
