

Dear Parent/Carer,

Please find attached information relating to the anticipated return of all young people to full-time in-school learning from 19<sup>th</sup> April 2021. Also attached is a summary letter for young people. This will be placed on their Year Group Teams pages. However I would be most grateful if you could pass this on to your young person(s) and discuss the expectations and procedures around the return to school with them.

The guidance for parents/carers is by its nature, lengthy. It is provided as a reference document for parents/carers and may be altered as arrangements change. To summarise its content however, please see the bullet points below:

- All pupils are anticipated to return to full-time, in-school learning from 19<sup>th</sup> April 2021
- Pupils should wear school uniform as usual
- Pupils should bring a face covering
- Pupils should come prepared for learning with any books, equipment, jotters, pens etc. you may need
- To begin with, all PE will take place outdoors
- Pupils will do practical activity in their practical subjects
- Pupils should try to distance from other pupils as much as they can
- Pupils should maintain 2 metre physical distancing from all adults
- S1-3 pupils will have different lunches and interval from S4-6 pupils
- Pupils should sanitise or wash their hands at every opportunity
- Pupils should think seriously about participating in the LFD COVID-19 testing
- On the first day back, pupils should go to their year group's outside area (same as before)
- If pupils go to a shop or takeaway at lunchtime, they will be regarded as members of the general public and need to follow the rules of those businesses
- Pupils will have toilets allocated according to their House group
- Pupils should follow the one way system and signage

I would thank parents/carers for their ongoing support of your young people and the school.
