Uniform Recycling

It is encouraging to see the vast majority of our young people continuing to represent the school well by wearing appropriate school uniform. We will keep supporting all pupils to ensure that these high standards remain. We have a well-accessed uniform recycling service, run by Friends at Braes. Should you wish to donate, or to pick up, items of good quality recycled uniform, please contact or visit the school reception. Alternatively your young person can speak with our office team, their Pastoral Head or any member of the senior leadership team. As a reminder, the Braes uniform consists of black leggings (without logos), trousers or skirt, white school shirt, black school jumper or cardigan, school tie. Track suit trousers, hoodies and zip up tops are not part of the school uniform and should not be worn to school. Young people can of course wear outdoor jackets to and from school. However we would be keen to see blazers being worn when in and around the school.
