

Dear Parent/Carer,

At Braes High, the ongoing monitoring of attainment and pupil progress is an important responsibility to which we give high priority. Our BGE (S1/2/3) tracking and monitoring system seeks to track learning achievements in classrooms and subject areas as a natural part of a young person's learning journey building up to a holistic sense of their progress across the year, identifying when interventions are required to support.

The current circumstances have made this more challenging for everyone, however, we have continued to provide feedback on all learners' progress and achievement over time and to share that information with parents at key points. Our BGE parents have received two tracking reports (October and December) with an opportunity to discuss their child's progress with staff at an online parents' evening in January/February.

Our final BGE tracking report is due to be sent out on 23<sup>rd</sup> April. However, in the spirit of ensuring you have the most accurate information reflecting your child's learning, we are going to delay this by one week for S1 and S2 pupils. Our third tracking report for S3 pupils is going to be delayed until June to ensure the holistic judgement of their learner journey in each subject truly reflects their BGE experience.

- S1/S2 Final Tracking report will be issued on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2021
- S3 Final Tracking report will be issued on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2021
