

Dear Pupil,

As you probably know, we expect that all pupils will be back in school, full-time from 19th April 2021. The arrangements for school will be broadly similar to what you experienced between August and December 2020. A detailed guidance document has been sent to your parents/carers and you will be able to read that too. However, some of the main points to be aware of from the 19th April are noted below :

- Wear school uniform
- Bring a face covering
- Come prepared for learning with any books, equipment, jotters, pens etc you may need
- You will be doing outdoors PE for now
- You will get to do practical activity in your practical subjects
- Try to distance from other pupils as much as you can
- Maintain 2 metre physical distancing from all adults
- S1-3 pupils will have different lunches and interval from S4-6 pupils
- Sanitise or wash your hands at every opportunity
- Think seriously about participating in the LFD COVID-19 testing
- On the first day back, go to your year group's outside area (same as before)
- If you go to a shop or takeaway at lunchtime, you need to follow their rules
- Use the toilet allocated to your House group
- Follow the one way system and signage

If you're worried about anything, speak to your Pastoral Head, or any other member of staff. If in doubt about anything, please ask a member of staff. Most of all, we want you to keep safe, learn well and enjoy being back in school.
