School Transport consultation

You may be aware that Falkirk Council have launched a consultation on eligibility of young people for free home-to-school transport. This will be of interest to Braes parents/carers and pupils. We will be advising young people of this consultation on Monday 6th February via their Year Group Teams pages, and would encourage parents/carers to make young people aware of this. Our Parent Council have also indicated a willingness to take forward any comments from parents/carers should families prefer to communicate in that way regarding the proposal. As you may be aware, Falkirk Council can provide Free School Meals, and payment towards the cost of school clothing and footwear (clothing grants) to the value of £120.00 per child/per year for primary school children, and £150.00 per child/per year for secondary school children.
