58/20 Apologies for Absence.

Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs. K. Burton, A. Mackrill and S. Gunter.

59/20 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

60/20 Minutes of the Previous Meeting

RESOLVED that the minutes of the Council meeting held on the 1st September 2020 be approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

61/20 Public Participation

There were no members of the public present.

62/20 To approve the design and cost of the VE / VJ Day anniversary memorial stone

Cllrs. Wynn, Coley and Osborne had met with Mr A. Wood from Wood for Stone Stonemasons. New drawings for the proposed design of the VE / VJ Day anniversary memorial stone were presented to the Council with three different stone inscription options. The total cost including materials and installation is £6500+VAT. It was **RESOLVED** that the Council go with the working group's recommended design and to approve the cost of the project.

63/20 To consider increasing the amount to be spent on bulbs for the recreation ground

Following a visit to the recreation ground by Cllrs. Wynn, Coley and Osborne a proposal was put to the Council to plant 8,000 large mixed crocus bulbs along the verge of the recreation ground hedge. Cllr. Wynn had received a quote of £520 from Boston Bulbs Wholesale including VAT and delivery. The clerk was asked to contact Hill Farm Landscapes to query about labour costs for planting of the bulbs. It was also suggested the Council may wish to involve the community in the planting. **RESOLVED** that the Council approve the cost of the bulbs but that further information will be needed on labour costs before making a final decision.
