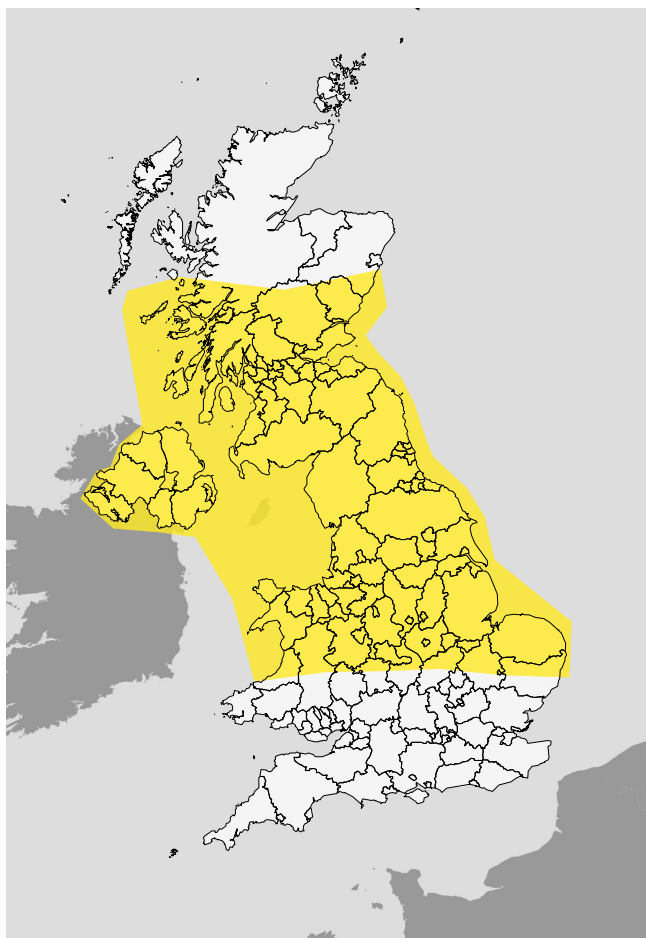

**Storm Dudley to bring a spell of very strong winds and possible disruption later Wednesday and into the small hours of Thursday****What to expect**

- Road, rail, air and ferry services may be affected, with longer journey times and cancellations possible, as well as some roads and bridges may close
- Damage to trees and buildings is possible
- Power cuts may occur
- Large waves may cause beach material to be thrown onto sea fronts and coastal roads

Further details

After a windy day, westerly winds are expected to increase further later on Wednesday afternoon and evening across southern Scotland, Northern Ireland, northern England, then parts of Wales, the Midlands and East Anglia.

There is still some uncertainty in the timing and location of the strongest winds but there is the potential for inland wind gusts of 60-70 mph in places.

The worst of the winds will ease through Thursday morning, though remaining generally windy during the day.
