Before & After School Club

The school house is designed with the school aged children in mind. It provides a safe and stimulating environment where your child can unwind after a busy day at school. There are lots of fun activities to take part in such as arts and crafts, wiii, role play room, construction suite, board games and lots of outdoor play. The staff plan a full programme for the children to enjoy and the children are encouraged to be part of the planning process, through our children's council. Ultimately this is their setting.

Three nights a week on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday we also offer a forest school out of school club, lead by our forest school lead. The children will take part in lots of outdoor activities, cooking on open fires and using real tools.

We open at 7.15am and provide our children with a selection of healthy cereals, toast, crumpets, fruit juice and breakfast biscuits.

Our after school club team, will collect your child (ren) from their classroom. We provide a home cooked tea, closing at 6pm.

We are located in the school house. A beautiful old building, that has been recently renovated for our children. To access the building, our entrance is next to the bakery on town street.

Holiday Playscheme

Our holiday playscheme's run's every school holiday and we are open from 7.30am—6.00pm everyday excluding bank holidays and the Christmas period. The days are full of exciting activities to do including trips such as, Bowling, Museums, parks, Farms and much more. So you can be assured that your children will have lots of fun during their school holidays.

We provide breakfast, a mid morning snack and a light afternoon tea. A packed lunch will need to be provided by yourself.

Once you are registered with us, you will receive a booking form with our programme. If you would like to book your child in, please return this form and payment to our admin team and they will confirm your booking.

Babysdays

We use a system called babysdays to register your child with us. We will send you a link to follow, so you can provide us with information about your family.

We also use babysdays to log any accidents or medication forms, along with sending emails.
