Sunday of the Most Holy Trinity 'Incomprehensible' in this life? Perfectly understood in the next!

The Athanasian Creed: We worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in Unity, neither confounding the persons, nor dividing the substance. There is one Person of the Father, another of the Son and another of the Holy Spirit. The Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit is all one, the glory equal, the majesty co-eternal... The Father 'uncreate', the Son 'uncreate', and the Holy Spirit 'uncreate'. The Father incomprehensible, the Son incomprehensible, and the Holy Spirit incomprehensible.

The Father eternal, the Son eternal, and the Holy Spirit eternal. They are not three eternal, but one eternal. There are not three uncreated nor three incomprehensible, but one uncreated and one incomprehensible. The Father is almighty, the Son almighty, and the Holy Spirit almighty; but they are not three almighties, but one almighty. The Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God. They are not three Gods, but one God. The Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, and the Holy Spirit is Lord. They are not three Lords, but one Lord.

We acknowledge every person by himself to be God and Lord... we are forbidden... to say: There are three Gods or three Lords. The Father is made of none, neither created nor begotten. The Son is of the Father alone; not made nor created, but begotten. The Holy Spirit is of the Father and of the Son; neither made, nor created, nor begotten, but proceeding. There is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons; one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits. In this Trinity none is afore, nor after another; none is greater, or less than another. The whole three persons are co-eternal, and co-equal... a Unity in Trinity and Trinity in unity.
