

### **Ash Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> February & Good Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2026**

Ash Wednesday & Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence.

*Fasting equates to eating only one full meal, and two snacks.*

*Abstinence is from meat, a collective act of the Catholic community.*

- Fasting is an obligation on Catholics aged 18 to 59 years.
- Abstinence is an obligation on Catholics aged 14 years and above.
- Abstinence applies every Friday, unless a Solemnity falls on a Friday.
- Remember our Lenten Penances are '*acts of love, not acts of torture*', so if for medical reasons you need to eat certain foods at specific times do not act contrary to your doctor's advice. Always take your medication.
- It remains a praiseworthy practice to give something up for Lent.

- 4.15pm on Saturdays<sup>1</sup> in St Joan of Arc, Farnham
- 5pm on Saturdays<sup>2</sup> in Holy Angels, Ash

There are ‘*Youth Confessions*’:

- At 5.45pm on Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> March in St Joan of Arc, Farnham

There will also be special days / sessions of Confessions:

- Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March in St Joan of Arc, Farnham
  - *After 11am Mass, 3pm to 4pm, 6.30pm to 7.30pm*
- 9am on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> March in Holy Angels, Ash

The Final Opportunity for Confessions will be on Holy Saturday (4<sup>th</sup> April)
