Qualification Structure

This qualification is assessed through completion of a portfolio of evidence.

- Individual self-study, research and evidence gathering at home under the guidance of your personal assessor
- Completion of an E-portfolio

There are no exams required to achieve the qualification

Qualification Duration

The duration of the qualification depends on if you have had prior learning or prior achievements, this may reduce the needed time to prepare for the assessment. However, the estimated total qualification time is 160 hours.

This equates to approximately a 4-month timescale but is dependent on a learner being engaged in their studies, submitting evidence to match the learning criteria usually on a weekly basis to your personal assessor.

Costs

This course is £185

50% is payable at point of enrolment with the remaining 50% payable upon completion of the qualification.

Who can enrol for this course?

Must be aged 16+.

Entry requirements

There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.

Who is this qualification suitable for?

The purpose of this qualification is to develop learners' knowledge and understanding in the area of end of life care and the involvement and actions they may take.

This qualification aims to develop the learner's knowledge and understanding of: The principles of end of life care and support, The importance of persons centred care in end of life practice, The impact of dementia in end of life care, How to provide support when working in end of life care, The loss and grief process.

The qualification will give learners working in, or intending to work in, healthcare and social care the knowledge and understanding of end of life care to support their role

The objective of this qualification is to support learners who currently work as health and social care workers or for individuals who are interested in this type of care work.

For individuals who currently work within the care sector, this qualification provides the opportunity to advance their knowledge and understanding and can be used as part of their CPD.

End of life care is a specialist area of care, but it is also acknowledged that quality end of life care should be provided by all carers when necessary. This qualification will provide learners with a basic understanding of how to approach end of life situations sensitively, respectfully, effectively and with a focus on quality

Completing this qualification Learners will develop their knowledge and understanding of: perspectives on death and dying; principles and policies of end of life care; communication in end of life care; and support services for end of life care

Certification
