### Qualification Structure

This qualification covers the safe moving and handling principles for both objects/load and the assistance of moving people. The practical aspects of this qualification mean we require an observation of the learner in practice.

You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification. Final assessment is via a multiple-choice exam which is graded as pass/fail.

This qualification is assessed by 2 forms of assessment for each of the 2 mandatory units.

- Unit 1: Manual handling safety at work Unit 1: Part 1 - Multiple-choice question (MCQ) examination Learning outcomes 1-3 are assessed by a 15-question multiple-choice examination that must be completed within 30 minutes. Successful learners will have to demonstrate knowledge across the assessment criteria within learning outcomes 1-3 and correctly answer at least 9 out of 15 questions or more to achieve a pass.
- Unit 1: Part 2 - Practical Assessment Learning outcome 4 is assessed by a competency-based assessment that is set by Highfield Qualifications and internally assessed and internally quality assured by the centre. Successful learners will need to achieve pass in each element of the practical assessment
- Unit 2: Moving People Safely Unit 2: Part 1 - Multiple-choice question (MCQ) examination Learning outcomes 1-3 are assessed by a 15-question multiple-choice examination that must be completed within 30 minutes. Successful learners will have to demonstrate knowledge across the assessment criteria within learning outcomes 1-3 and correctly answer at least 9 out of 15 questions or more to achieve a pass.
- Unit 2: Part 2 - Practical Assessment Learning outcome 4 is assessed by a competency-based assessment that is set by Highfield Qualifications and internally assessed and internally quality assured by the centre. Successful learners will need to successfully demonstrate the relevant practical assessments.

### Qualification Duration

The total qualification duration for this course is 40 hours.  
We recommend 20 guided learning hours for this course.

This equates to approximately a 1-month timescale but is dependent on a learner being engaged in their studies, submitting evidence to match the learning criteria usually on a weekly basis to your personal assessor

#### Costs

This course is £250  
50% is payable at point of enrolment with the remaining 50% payable upon completion of the qualification.

#### Who can enrol for this course?

Must be age 16+.  
This course is for workers where the assistance and movement of people is part of their role.

#### Entry requirements

There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum Entry Level 1 in Literacy or numeracy or equivalent.

#### Who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is suitable for:

- Those starting work
- Those returning to work
- Those needing specific training
- Care workers
- Personal Assistant

This qualification will provide learners with the skills, knowledge and understanding required for those working in areas/sectors where the assistance and movement of people is part of their role.

The objective of the qualification is to prepare learners for employment or to support a role in the workplace. The qualification is suitable for those starting work, returning to work or who need specific training in the movement of people safely, as well as being a suitable qualification for safety refresher training.
