Qualification Structure

You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification. Final assessment is via a multiple-choice exam which is graded as pass/fail.

At the end of this course there will be a multiple-choice question examination containing 15 questions that must be completed within 30 minutes. Learners must achieve a minimum pass mark of 60%.

Qualification Duration

Total duration time for this course is 6 hours and we recommend 6 guided learning hours.

Costs

This course is £90

Who can enrol for this course?

Must be aged 16+.

Entry requirements

There are no specific entry requirements however learners should have a minimum of level 1 in literacy and numeracy or equivalent.
