Qualification Structure

You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification. Final assessment is via a multiple-choice exam which is graded as pass/fail.

This qualification is externally set and assessed by a 15-question multiple-choice examination that must be completed within 30 minutes. Successful learners will have to demonstrate knowledge across the unit content and correctly answer 9 questions or more to achieve a pass

Qualification Duration

The duration of the qualification depends on whether you have had prior learning or prior achievements, as this may reduce the time spent preparing for the assessment. However, the total time for this qualification is 6 hours. 5 of which are recommended as guided learning hours.

Costs

This course is £70

50% is payable at point of enrolment with the remaining 50% payable upon completion of the qualification

Who can enrol for this course?

Must be aged 16+.

Entry requirements

There are no prerequisites for this qualification, although it is recommended that learners have a minimum of level 1 in English or equivalent.

Who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is designed for learners working in workplaces, such as:

- Transport
- Classroom environments

This qualification is aimed at learners who have access to any environment where coming into contact with hazardous substances is likely.

The qualification provides learners with the knowledge and skills needed to recognise the risks associated with hazardous substances and how to control them.

The objective of the qualification is predominantly to support a role in the workplace, however, may also be suitable for younger learners preparing for employment or wishing to progress onto further learning in a related subject.
