### Qualification Structure

You will be assigned a personal assessor who will help guide you through the learning criteria for this qualification, delivered as a distance learning qualification. Final assessment is via a multiple-choice exam which is graded as pass/fail.

This qualification is assessed by a 20-question multiple-choice examination that must be completed within 45 minutes. Successful learners will have to demonstrate knowledge across the unit content and correctly answer 12 questions or more to achieve a pass.

### Qualification Duration

Duration of this qualification is 7 hours.  
We recommend 6 guided learning hours.

### Costs

This course is £70  
50% is payable at point of enrolment with the remaining 50% payable upon completion of the qualification.

### Who can enrol for this course?

This course is aimed at anyone involved in the management of fire safety who are based in any area where there is a potential risk of fire. Also suitable for younger learners preparing for employment or wishing to progress further in a related subject.

### Entry requirements

Learners are required to be 16 years of age or above.  
We recommend learners to have a minimum Level 1 in English or equivalent.

### Who is this qualification suitable for?

This qualification is designed for:

- Young learner wishing to progress in said subject or related
- Workers involved in the management of Fire Safety
- Anyone above the mentioned age limit wishing to learn more about Fire Safety

The objective of the qualification is predominantly to support a role in the workplace, however may also be suitable for younger learners preparing for employment or wishing to progress onto further learning in a related subject.

Learners gaining this qualification will know that fire safety is the responsibility of everyone and will recognise the causes of fire as well as knowing common hazards, the steps in a fire risk assessment and how to reduce the likelihood of fires.
