WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE LADYBIRD CLASS




The Ladybird Room will be:

Making elephant handprint pictures.


Mark making using a variety of items; chalk, dabbers and paint.

The Caterpillar Room will be:


Looking at flash cards with key words to do with the circus to expand their vocabulary.

Making clown faces.


Drawing around their hands to make crazy hair.
