Overview

The knowledge requirements of this qualification aim to provide candidates with an understanding of the techniques and practices required for the delivery of non-surgical, aesthetic, injectable treatments. Learners will develop their knowledge and understanding of relevant health and safety pertaining to the Level 7 aesthetic treatments alongside relevant ethical and legal requirements to treatment, key treatment principles, the methods of and reasons for patient-centred assessment, how psychology influences aesthetic medicine and the key principles of anatomy and physiology relevant to the treatment modalities.

Level 7 Post Graduate Diploma



Overview

The competence requirements of this qualification aim to consolidate the knowledge elements with related practical skills. These aim to convey the ability to deliver dependably high quality, safe, and client-centred botulinum toxin and dermal filler treatments.

The Diploma theory is conducted online, and can be completed around your schedule over the course of 9-12 months.



Course Agenda

Start with Online learning, where you will gain understanding of facial anatomy, the aging process, patient assessment and consultation, and the principles and practice of aesthetic injectables.

The learning contains 150hrs of e-learning over the course of six interactive modules each concluded with a set of multiple choice questions to test your knowledge. E-learning has been designed for medical professionals to complete alongside their existing work commitments as a flexible, self-managed course, however completing the first three modules on gaining access to the VLE will best prepare you for your practical training, allowing you to fully focus on your injecting skills on the practical day.

Overview

The Foundation Course is designed for medical professionals who want to start learning about aesthetic injectables. It offers an introduction to botulinum toxin and dermal fillers. This training course provides a blended learning experience to ensure that you are fully knowledgeable in both the theory and practice of some of the most popular treatment areas. Practical Training

After the presentation, we will provide hands-on training with patient models. Delegates will be given a logbook to record cases. While logging cases is mandatory only for those pursuing their Level 7 Diploma, we recommend that all delegates complete the logbook. This will allow you to use cases from your Foundation Course if you later decide to upgrade to the Diploma.



Online Learning

Our Level 7 Diploma program students will access their course material through a Virtual Learning Environment (VLE). - The Advanced Mentorship Day is only required if you have not completed your log book of treatments- you must supply models for areas you require.




Diploma Assessment

Once you have completed Stages One and Two's practical training and online modules through our Virtual Learning Environment, it is time to undertake Stage Three, the final assessment stage in gaining your Level 7 Diploma in Facial Aesthetics.

Although many delegates find it useful to complete Stages One and Two ahead of moving on to Stage Three, the following assessments can be completed in parallel to practical training.

you will also need to complete a 2 hour written exam in order to successfully pass the Diploma.



Patient Logbook

Your practical training is assessed by the completion of a Logbook of forty patients drawn from across your training days during Stage One and Two, and signed off by your trainer. This is comprised of:

- 10 Toxin Treatments observed
- 10 Toxin Treatments practiced
- 10 Filler Treatments observed
- 10 Filler Treatments Practiced

Written Assessment

The Written Assessment is made up of a Risk Assessment, a Critical Literature Review and a Case Study:

Please take note of the following information:-
You will have 1 assignment to undertake which will cover UMA 4 and 5 and it is scenario based, so we recommend you have completed all your practical training before you submit this.

After completing your practical training, assessments, exam, and submitting your logbook, your work will be externally marked if you pass you will be awarded the Level 7 Diploma in Facial Aesthetics. Any resits will have a fee for the examination board.
