**Eligibility Criteria:** NMC, GDC, GPC, HCPC

**Skill Level:** Suitable for aesthetic practitioners with over 3 years in practice and who have already completed more than 40 botulinum toxin and 40 dermal filler treatments (evidence required) ; certificates of training, a completed log of 40 filler and toxin treatments,a clinical reference from a peer who is an aesthetic medical professional and evidence of insurance to cover the 3 years in practice (We provide log book templates and a clinical reference template)

# Process:

You must be able to provide the evidence required to enable you to join the fast-track course.

There will be a 2-3 hour online exam and an OSCE (carrying out a botulinum toxin and dermal filler case under assessment by our qualified assessor)

**Apply for Level 7 using our on-boarding form.**

**Pay for course either in full £2500 or a deposit of £1000 followed by 3 monthly payments of £510 (£30 extra administration fee)**

**Once you have completed the application forms  
we will email you to provide your further  
evidence.**

**These will be reviewed and we will contact you  
within 3 working days to enroll you or further  
discuss any of the evidence.**

**You will then be given access to the online learning portal within 48 hours.**

**You will have 12 months to complete the level 7. Once you feel you have learned enough of the theoretical side, you can apply for the written exam- you can now pick any date that suits you- we must know in advance as our envigilator is required to sit in on teams.**

**Once you have undertaken the written exam you can proceed to book your OSCE.**

**This will be booked through the assessor.**

**This can also be carried out online teams and is recorded for internal and external quality assurance.**

**You will require one model for 2 areas of soft tissue filler;**

**1 model for 3 areas toxin (we will attach the marking criteria so you can see what you need to do, if you're not a prescriber they will need to be present)**

Exams are Externally marked  
so you will need to wait for  
results, usually within 48 hours
