

A LOOK BACK AT FEBRUARY'S HIGHLIGHTS



WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE LADYBIRD ROOM






WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE CATERPILLAR ROOM



Caterpillar book of the month will be: "On the Farm, by Axel Scheffler"




WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH IN THE BUTTERFLY ROOM
