



## INFORMING GENERAL PUBLIC: SAFETY AND SECURITY MESSAGING

### Travel Advisories

Our clear, timely and reliable safety and security information helps the General Public make informed decisions about their time and movement during this period. The TSSF provides information on the internet through Safety and Security Messaging Systems (SSMS) and on social media.

While we issue an overall Travel Advisory level for every state, levels of advice may vary for specific locations or areas within a state. For instance, we may advise the General Public to “Exercise Increased Caution” (Level B) in a state, but to “Reconsider Travel” (Level C) to a particular area within the Country

### TIMELY AND RELIABLE INFORMATION

We review and update each Travel Advisory as needed, based on changes to security and safety information. In addition to these “as needed” reviews, we review (Level C) and D Advisories weekly, and Level A and B Advisories monthly. Visit our website [www.tssf.org.ng](http://www.tssf.org.ng)

### ALERTS

Alerts are used to notify members of the Public of specific events and changes happening locally, as our usual practice and as quickly as possible. The TSSF- SSMS will let you know the particular location and type of threat, making the process efficient and allowing you to get information as quickly as

### Travel Advisories

We issue a Travel Advisories for the General Public, providing overall levels of advice from A to D

#### LEVEL: A

#### EXERCISE NORMAL PRECAUTION

**LEVEL A** – Exercise Normal Precautions. This is the lowest advisory level for safety and security risk. There is no risk in any international travel but your movement to and from Nigeria Airport may be at risk. Conditions in other countries may differ from those in Nigeria and may change from Airport to Airport at any time.

#### LEVEL: B

#### EXERCISE INCREASED CAUTION

**LEVEL B** – Exercise Increased Caution. Be aware of heightened risks to safety and security. The media houses provides up to date information and additional advice for the general public. Conditions in any state may change from time to time.

#### LEVEL: C

#### RECONSIDER TRAVEL

**LEVEL C** – Reconsider Travel: Avoid travel due to serious risks to safety and security. The Media houses provides up to date information and additional advice for the general public. Conditions in any state may change at any time

#### LEVEL: D

#### DO NOT TRAVEL

**LEVEL D** – Do Not Travel: This is the highest advisory level due to greater likelihood of life-threatening risks. During an emergency, the government may have very limited ability to provide assistance. TSSF advises members of the public not travel to any place or leave as soon as it is safe to do so. We provides additional advice for anyone who may want to travel for urgent reasons. Conditions in any state may change at any time.
