




## THE FIRE PLACE CHESHAM

INSTALLATION MAINTENANCE SWEEPING

### The importance of using dry wood.

Burning wet wood will lead to an increase in smoke and emissions and produce less heat. It causes blackening of the glass and a build-up of soot in the chimney. Using dry wood means that fewer logs are required to produce the same level of heat, saving money and reducing emissions.

## A BASIC GUIDE TO LIGHTING YOUR STOVE.

1. Fully open the primary & secondary air supplies
2. Add 1-2 Firelighters
3. Stack a generous amount of kindling around the firelighters.
4. Light your fire
5. Once firelighter are alight. Close door, leaving slightly ajar.
6. Leave the kindling to establish a good fire. After 5-10minutes the flue will be warmed and the chimney will draw well.



7. Add more wood. Start with smaller logs.
  8. After a further 20-30 minutes add larger logs.
  9. Close the door
  10. Close the primary air feed.
- Note: If you're burning solid fuels close the secondary airfeed and keep the primary open.
