



RISK ASSESSMENT



Make sure suitable all weather outside cables are used for connection to the mains power supply

All equipment and cables to be visually inspected before use



Be aware of where all the fire exits are located.

Do not block fire exits and make sure all cables are taped/covered in front of the fire exits



Although our snow and bubble fluid is non-hazardous, we recommend keeping away from eyes, if contact is made with eyes you should wash them with water.



The average level of music should not exceed 90 decibels

All speakers and equipment stands should be set up securely and on a level surface to prevent risk of falling over

Children should not to be in the area where we are setting up and packing down the disco



Children to be kept away from area where our vehicles are loading/unloading


Entertainer to make extra checks whilst entertaining and leaving the loading area, hazard lights to be switched on

Safety mats to be used in areas where bubbles & foam are used to help prevent slips and falls

Make sure the party area is level and free from trip hazards, as we run a variety of active games
