



Course title: Automated External Defibrillator (AED) & Basic Life Support (BLS)

Duration: Half Day

Course overview:

This course is designed to provide learners with the knowledge and skills to operate an AED safely whilst learning how to preserve a life using current CPR protocols. The training is an ideal course for first aiders wishing to upgrade their skills or learners who wish to learn to operate these lifesaving devices.

- Discuss and practice the Primary Survey
- Demonstrate effective management of an unresponsive casualty who is breathing normally
- Demonstrate effective management of an unresponsive casualty who is not breathing normally
- Discuss the chain of survival
- Discuss the common reasons of Cardiac Arrest
- Describe the physiology and anatomy of the heart
- Discuss, demonstrate, and imitate how to safely use an automated external defibrillator
- Discuss the importance of recording and reporting an incident

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
