- The Butterfly Room Graduation will be held on Thursday 13 July at 2pm for all the children who will be starting school in September.




A massive Thank You to everyone who participated in our Comic Relief Bake Off. I hope everyone had as much fun as we did!


We raised a massive £250.00 all of which has been sent off to the charity.

Butterfly Room Topic



The Butterflies will be learning about the life cycles of a variety of animals including butterflies. Once again, to help the children learn we will be purchasing caterpillars, so the children have a visual learning experience. The children will observe the caterpillars as they go through the different stages of transformation until we get our beautiful butterflies which we can release into our garden.

Caterpillar Room Topic



During April the Caterpillars will be learning about animal life cycles, as well as how plants grow and develop.

We will use this opportunity to discuss big and small flowers. We will also talk about where vegetables come from and what they need to help them grow. We will be planting some small vegetables and assisting the children in caring for the plants. Once the plants are fully grown, we will show the children how to harvest them. This can lead to them tasting food they wouldn't normally try.

Baby Room Topic



The Babies will be looking at Baby Animals and learning the correct names. They will also be introduced to texture-based vocabulary, such as soft, fluffy and smooth, as well as size-based language.
