

Contract for the supply of 'The Fed Line Project' sessions / programme to service users via a third-party client.

Terms & Conditions

Thank you for requesting The Fed Line Project services. We are looking forward to working with you.

COOKERY SESSIONS To ensure the safety of all attendees at The Fed Line Project sessions we require agreement of the below terms and conditions. The third-party clients (ie. the person / organisation who has requested our services) is responsible for this agreement in lieu of individual consent/details of service users.

Prior to the session:

In order to comply with our terms and conditions we ask that The Fed Line Project service provider is notified in writing by the third party of:

Any participants with food allergies / intolerances / preferences: In such cases we may require further information (please see allergy form) so we can assess the suitability of our sessions. In the unlikely event we cannot cater for a particular allergy/intolerance/preference we will notify you. We reserve the right to exclude individuals who we are unable to cater for.

All participants are expected to behave appropriately, act with caution and work safely at our sessions and we ask third parties to support this. If a participant's behaviour is deemed dangerous or poses health and safety risks during a session, the third party will be notified, and the participant may be excluded.

Participant Welfare: Participants are not permitted to taste foods that contain raw eggs or raw meat used in preparation during our sessions. Our sessions are designed to be safe however some preparation methods could be harmful (eg. using the hobs, using knives etc). We will advise on the safest way to use equipment to mitigate any risks, but will not be held responsible should injury occur. The third party must notify us in writing should certain individuals not be permitted to use certain equipment.

No children (anyone under 18 years) are permitted to join the class or enter the kitchen / cookery area whilst the class is underway. For any vulnerable adults or adults with special educational needs or disabilities please be aware that we will not be able to provide any additional help to individuals during the session. We welcome care givers to attend the session to support all learners where necessary.

Liabilities: We accept participants to our sessions on the assumption that they are in good health. It is the responsibility of the participant, and you as the booking client, to alert us to any medical complaint or history of illness suffered by attendees. Please note attendees will be standing for 2 hours at our class and working in a warm kitchen environment. We do not accept responsibility for the medical management of attendees at our sessions at any time. In the event of an emergency, the third-party consents. The Fed Line Project session provider to seek any necessary emergency medical advice or treatment during the running of the cookery session.

We do not accept loss or damage arising from errors or omissions on the Registration Form whether completed by you or by an attendee at the time of completion. We do not accept liability for infection or illness derived from attendance at The Fed Line Project sessions. We do not accept liability for death or personal injury to any participants attending The Fed Line Project, or any activity related to The Fed Line Project whether organised by The Fed Line Project or otherwise save to the

extent that such death or injury shall be caused by the negligence or default of any member of our staff or any other default on our part.

Other Losses: We do not accept responsibility for any loss or expense due to circumstances beyond our control, including, but not limited to, delays in public transport, weather, quarantine, sickness, bereavement, strikes or other industrial action, terrorism, fire and riot. Without prejudice to the other terms of this agreement, in no event (including our own negligence) will we be liable for any: a) economic losses (including, without limitation, loss of revenues, profits, contracts, business or anticipated savings); b) loss of goodwill or reputation; c) any other special, indirect or consequential losses; or d) loss to third parties.

Limitations: No provision of these Terms and Conditions shall operate or be construed to operate so as to exclude or restrict our liability under the provisions of any UK legislation in force from time to time which are not capable of being excluded or restricted. Save as otherwise required by UK legislation, our total liability for any loss, damages, costs or expenses shall not exceed an amount equal to the invoice value for the services provided.

DEPOSIT: For fees payable by the client / organisation, a 50% non-refundable deposit is required on booking to secure dates. The remaining fee (50%) is payable in advance of the first session.

FEE: £1,820 per course of 4 sessions. Please note – the session fee is for up to 10 people and is based on attendance. Refunds and credits will not be given for days where participants do not attend or the if class is cancelled by the booking client or service users.

PAYMENT/ CANCELLATION POLICY: It is agreed that a minimum of two weeks written notice must be given by the client for cancellation of a 4-week Course.

The deposit is non-refundable.

Any costs incurred by The Fed Line Project relating to the recovery of fees will be added to any amount outstanding.

ILLNESS POLICY It is agreed that any participant who is ill (eg fever, infection, diarrhoea, communicable disease, or any other type or illness that may be passed on to others, with the exception of the common cold) will be unable to attend our sessions. If a member of The Fed Line Project is unable to attend due to illness, every reasonable attempt will be made to provide another class leader to run the session. No fee will be charged if the session is unable to take place due to the provider being unable to provide the service.
