

CAS UKMON Report to CAS Committee Meeting 11/01/2018

This report covers activities between the 19th November 2017 and the 4th January 2018 of the CAS Meteor Observation Camera 2 located as part of the Society Observatory at National Trust Dyffryn Gardens.


Camera 2 captured 163 meteor trails in November 2017 and 236 meteor trails in December 2017 of which 67 were Geminids; no fireball events were recorded.

The CAS website CAS_UKMON entry has been updated to the end of October 2017 for Camera 1, end December 2017 for Camera 2 and today for this report and general information. There is also now a "Calendar of Visible Meteor Events 2018".

The UKMON central database has been updated to the end of October 2017 for Camera 1 and the end of December 2017 for Camera 2.

During the week commencing 4th December there were power supply issues to the Observatory, these were reported to the Dyffryn Gardens Maintenance Officer, he was already aware of the problem as it affects the biomass boiler and had electricians engaged to resolve the circuit tripping. In short, the supply circuit was being overloaded with the number of electric heaters that keep the orchids and cacti warm in the polytunnels. The UPS on the UKMON PC appears to have kept the system running during these power outages.
